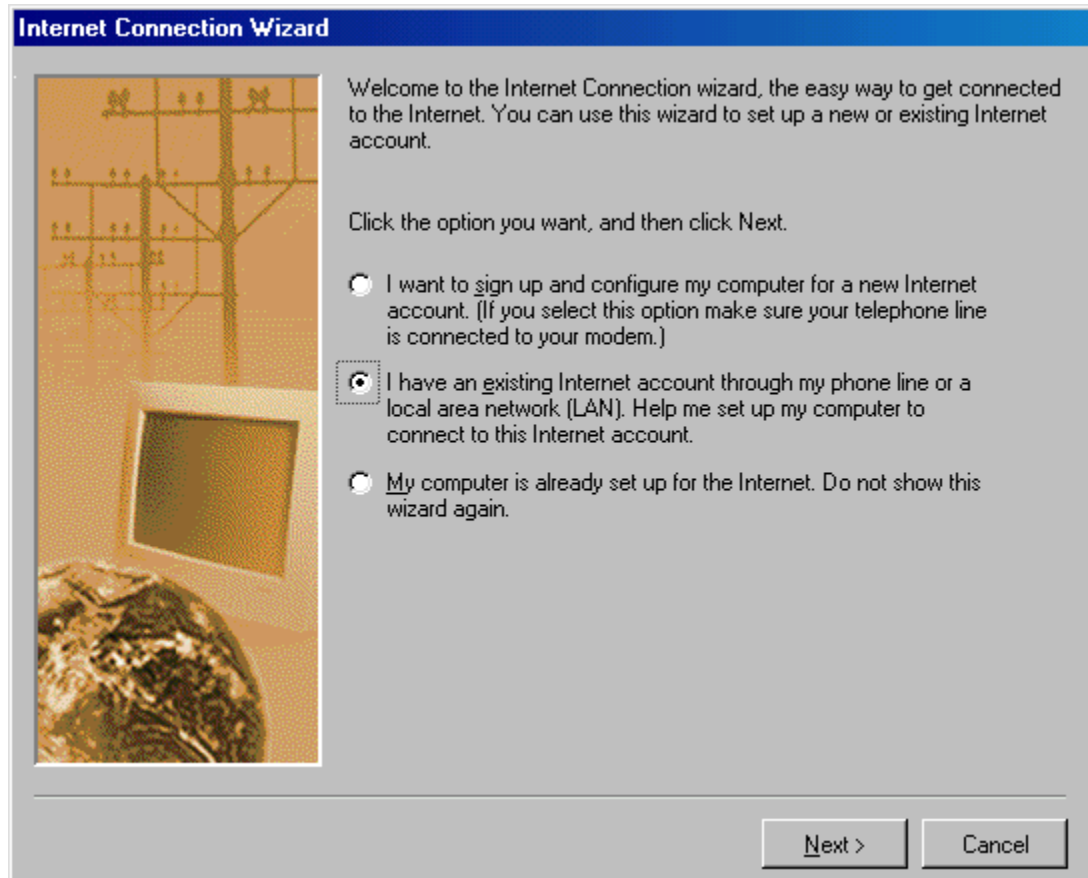
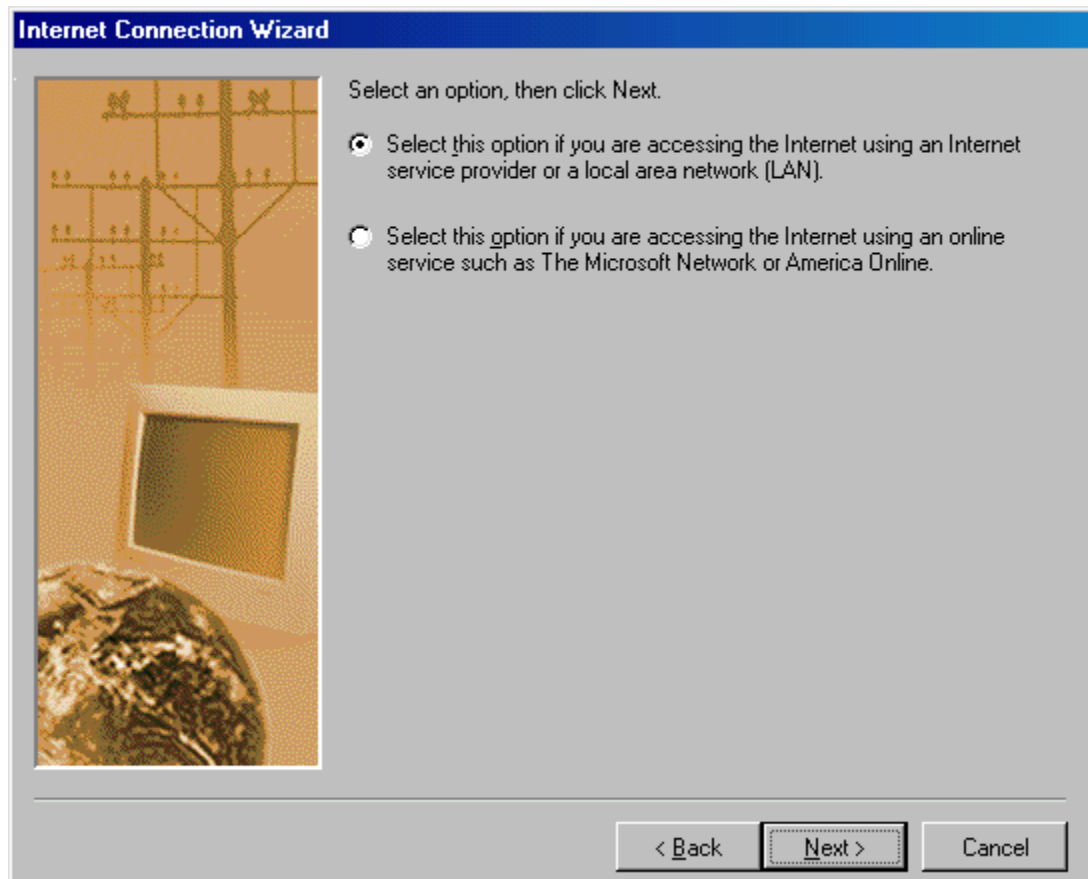


Dial-up Setup: Windows 98/95

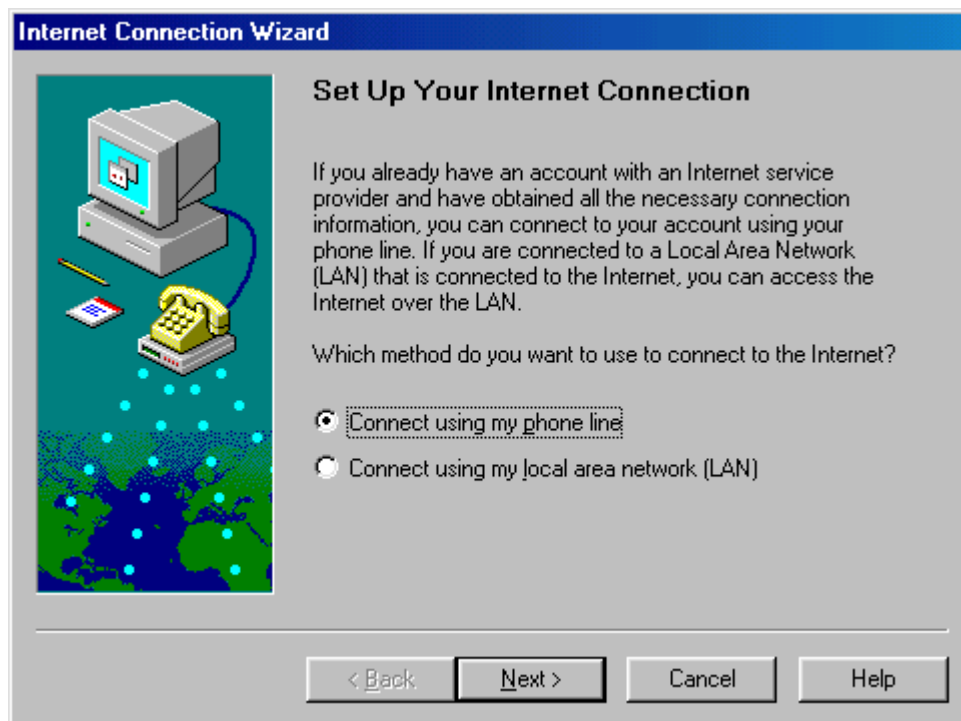
1. To set up your computer for a dialup internet connection you will use the **Internet Connection Wizard**. To begin the wizard go to **Start > Settings > Control Panel**. Then, double-click on the **Internet** icon. Choose the **Communications** tab and click the **Connect** button.
2. You have now entered the **Internet Connection Wizard**. On the first screen choose the second option and click **Next**.



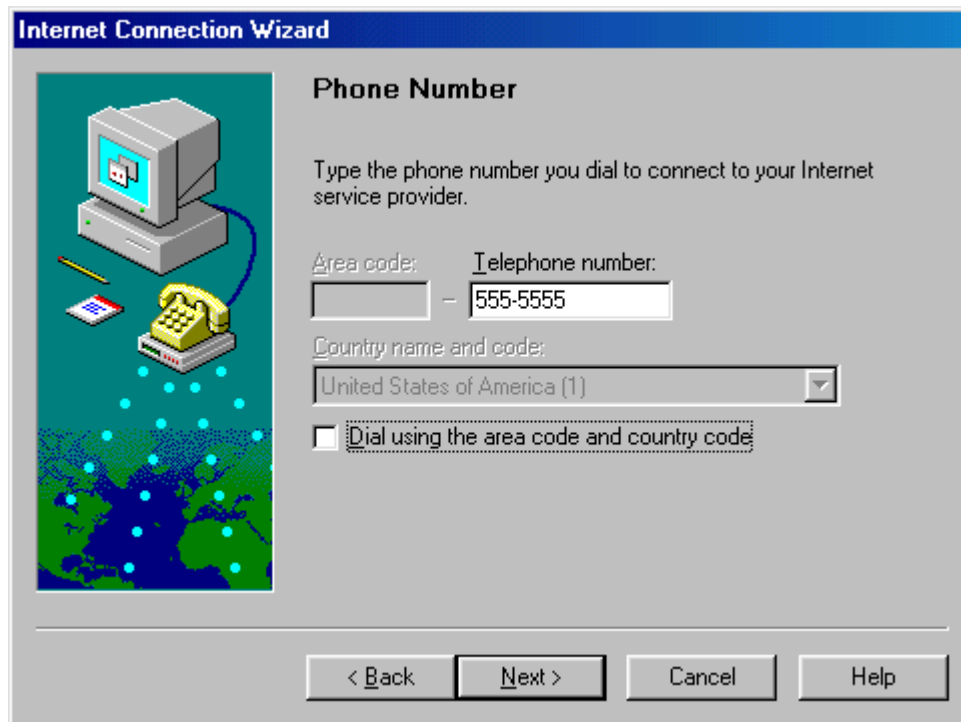
3. Leave the first option selected ('...Internet service provider...'). Click **Next**.



- Again, leave the first option selected ('Connect using my phone line'). Click **Next**.



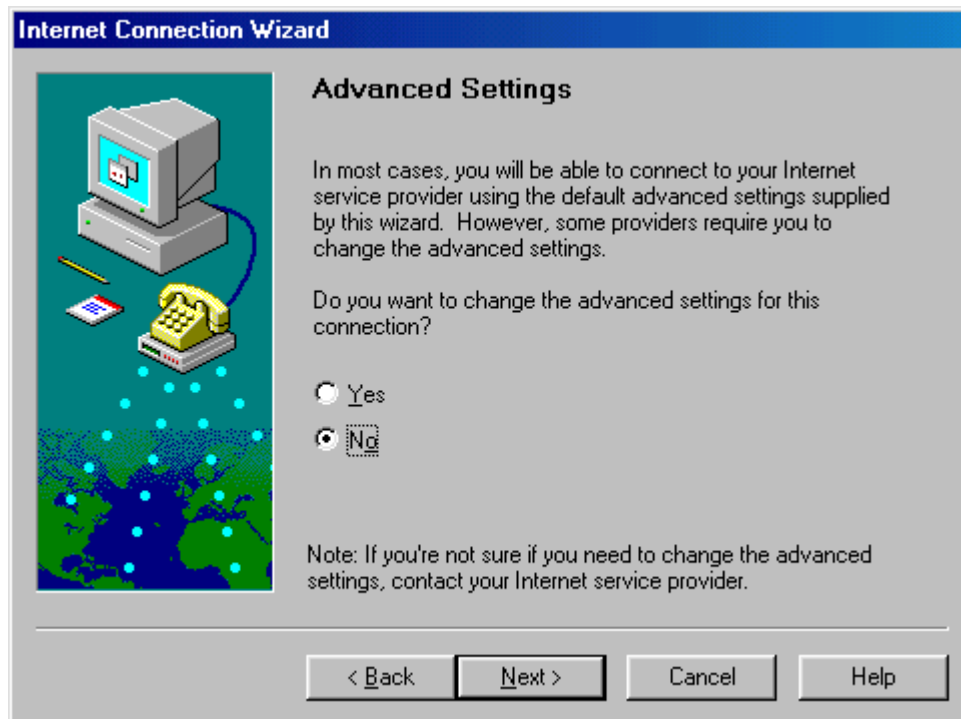
- Enter the local access phone number for your area. Click **Next**.



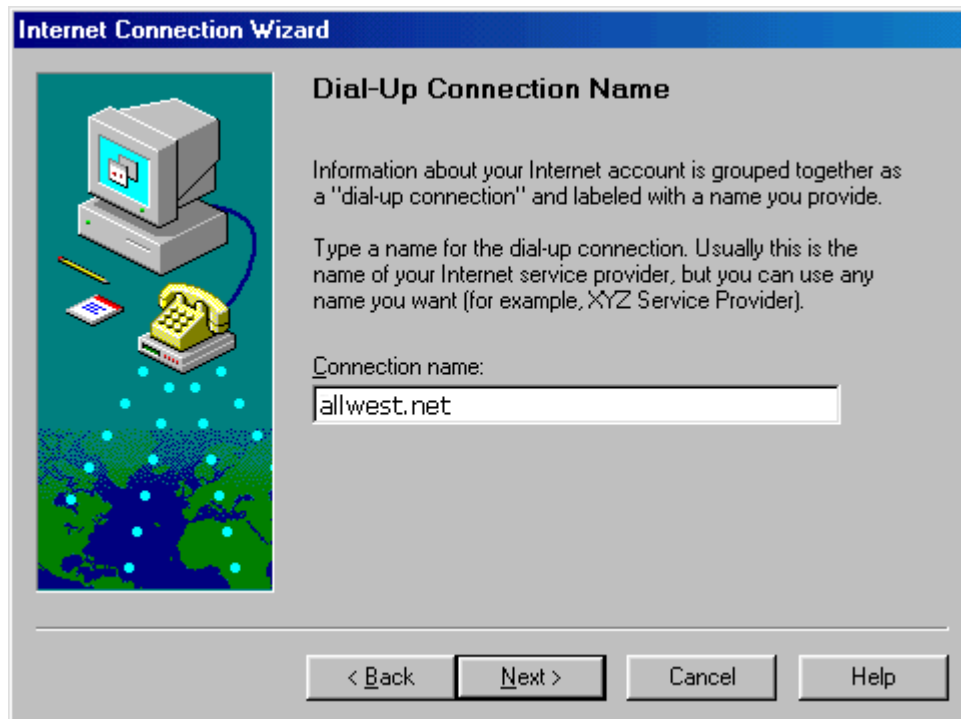
6. Enter the username and password for your account. Click **Next**.



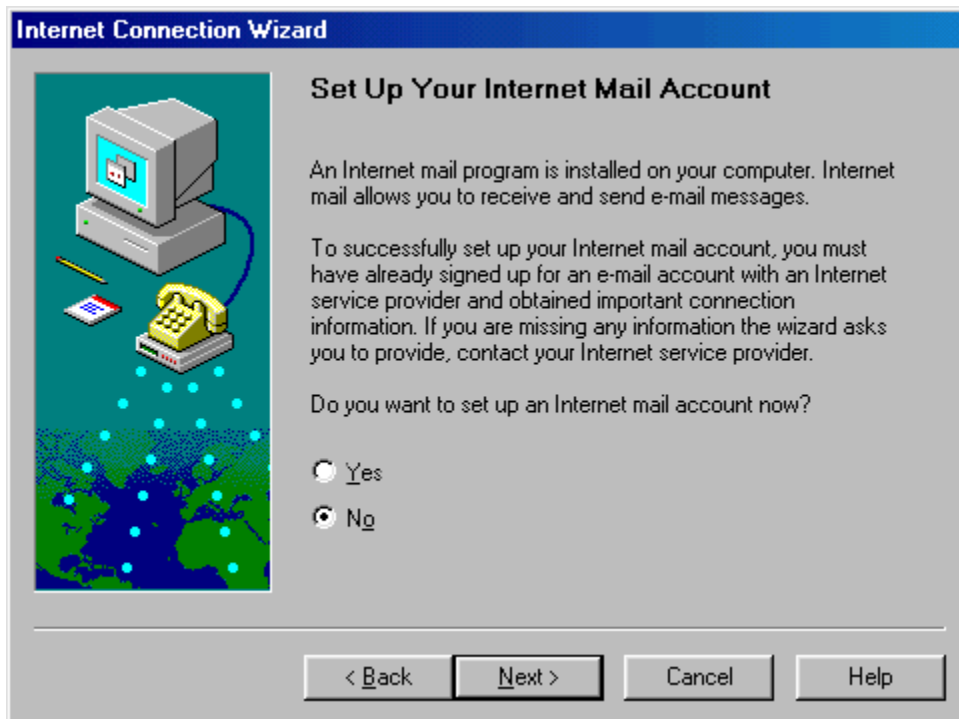
7. Choose **No** when asked if you want to change your Advanced Settings. Click **Next**.



8. Name your Dial-Up Connection 'allwest.net'. Click **Next**.



9. You have finished setting up your dial-up connection. You can continue on and set up your email (Outlook Express) at this time by choosing **Yes** or choose **No** to finish the wizard. Click **Next**.
