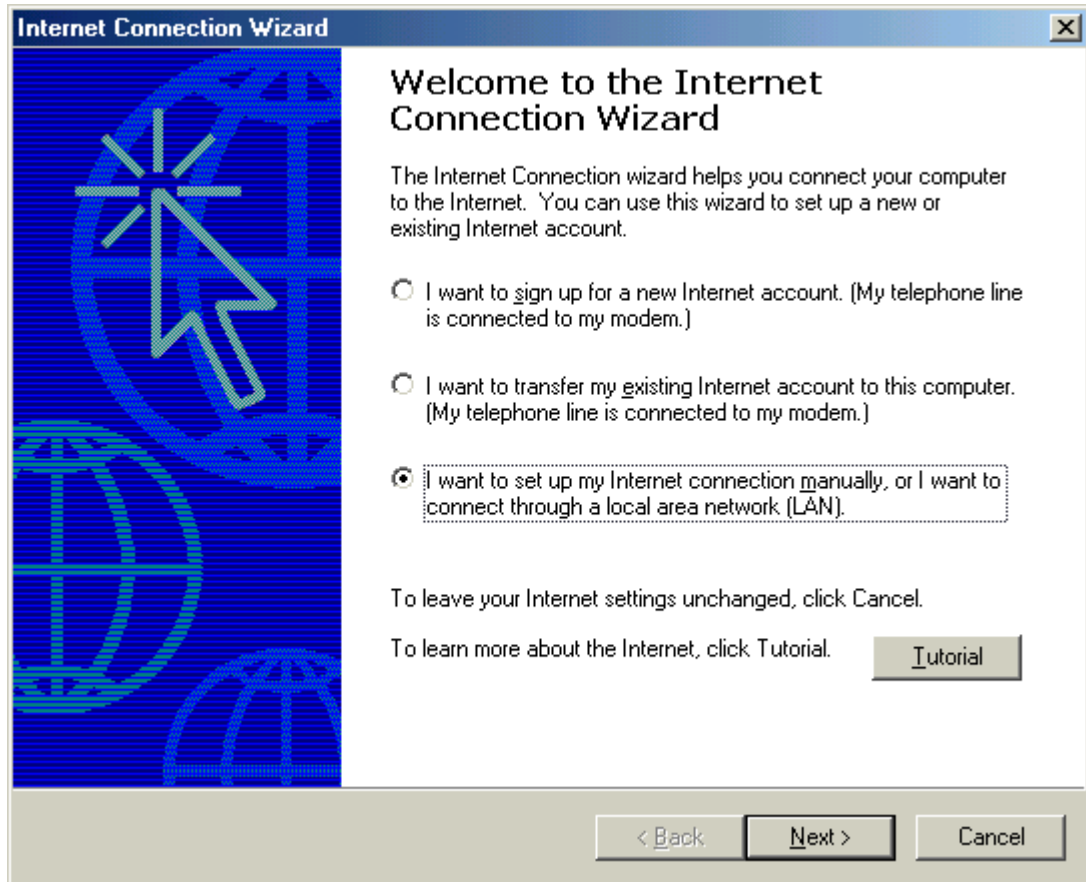
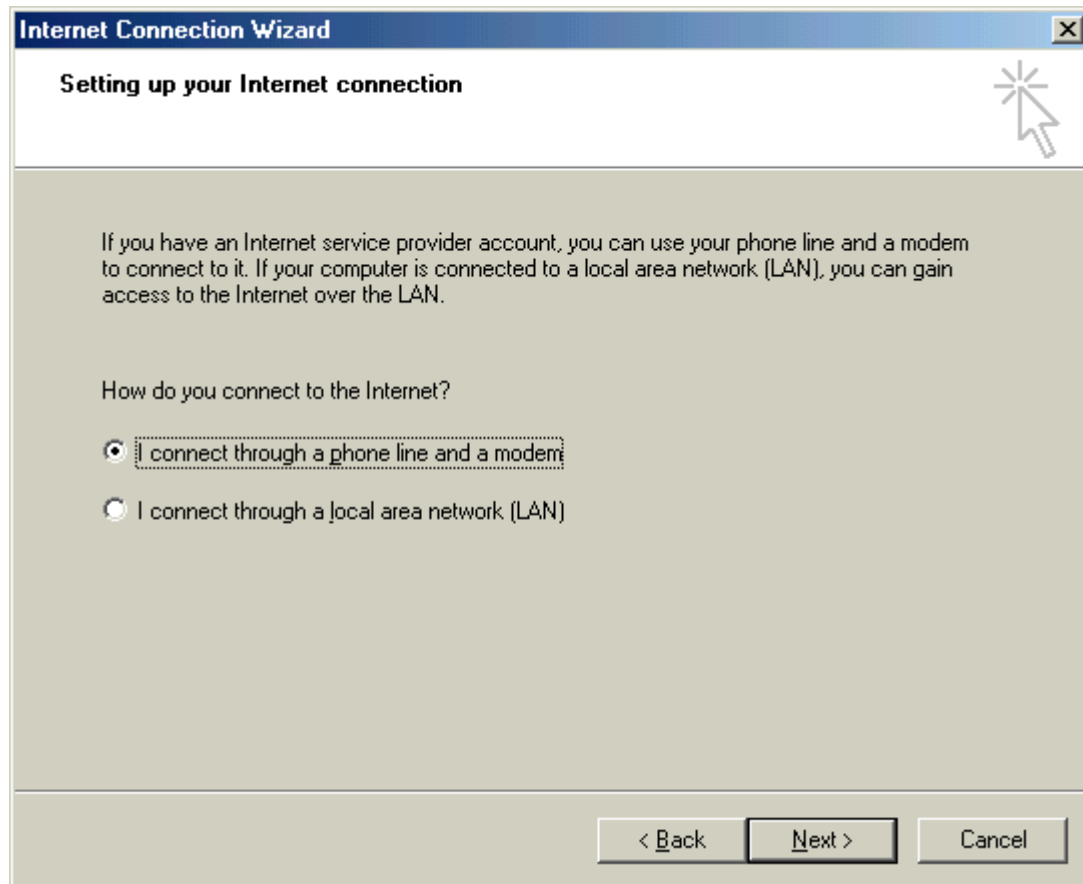


Dial-up Setup: Windows 2000/NT

1. To set up your computer for a dialup internet connection you will use the **Internet Connection Wizard**. To begin the wizard go to **Start > Settings > Control Panel**. Then, double-click on the **Internet** icon. Choose the **Communications** tab and click the **Connect** button.
2. You have now entered the **Internet Connection Wizard**. On the first screen choose the third ('set up... manually...') option and click **Next**.



3. Leave the first option ('...phone line and a modem') selected. Click **Next**.



4. Enter the local access phone number for your area. Click **Next**.

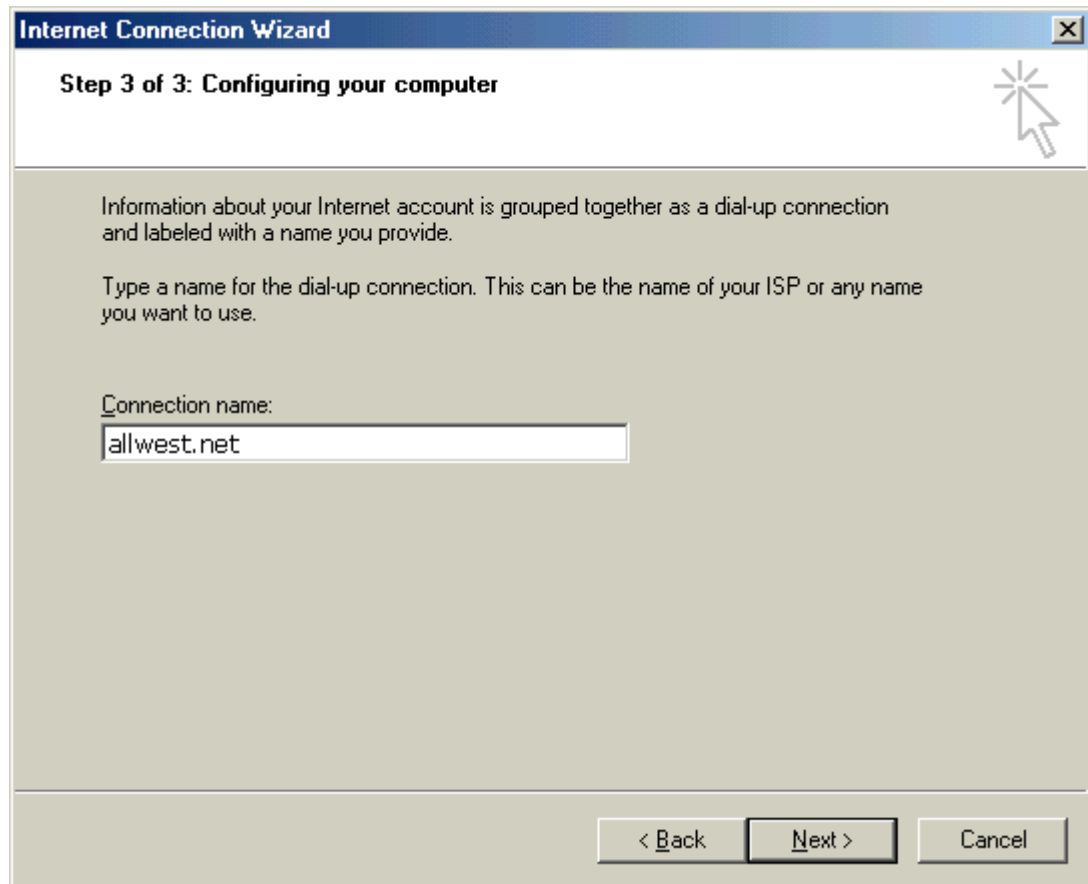
Type the user name and password you use to log on to your ISP. Your user name may also be referred to as your Member ID or User ID. If you do not know this information, contact your ISP.

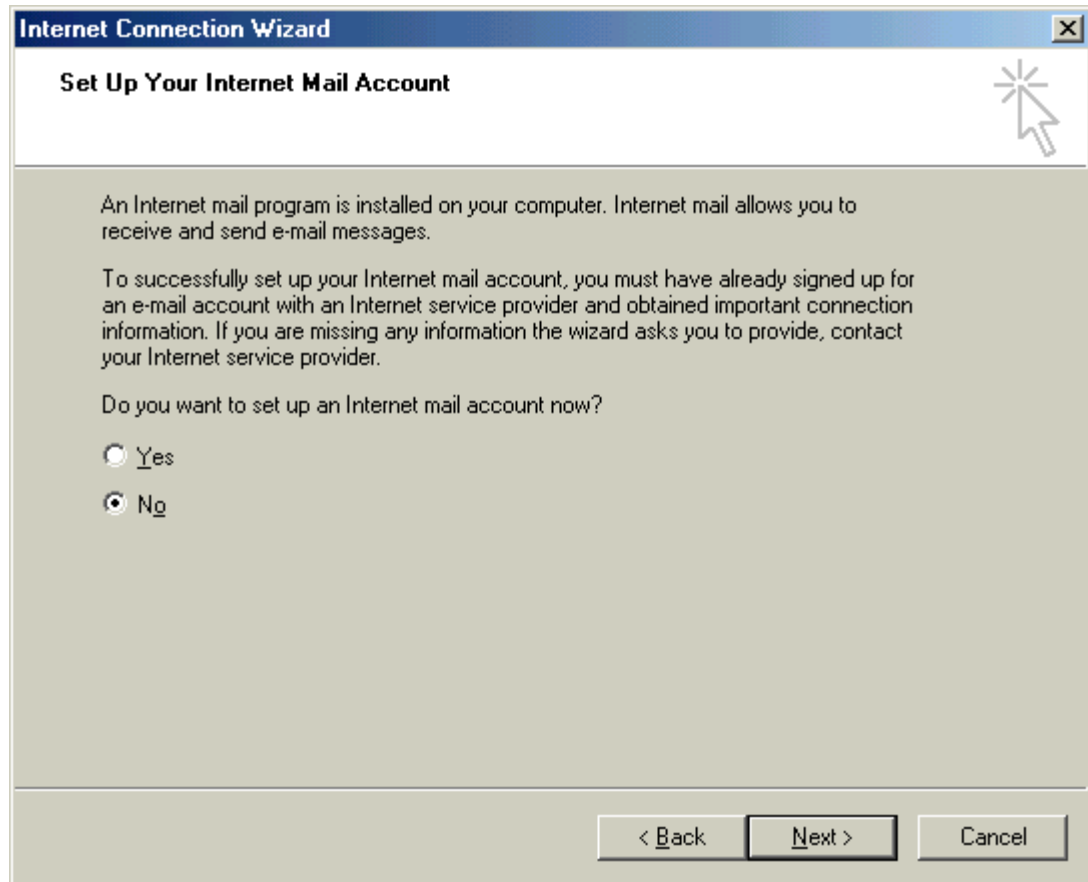
