

PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING THE 2017 NOVEMBER ELECTION

Public Notice is hereby given that the Municipalities of Henefer, Coalville, Oakley, Kamas, Francis, and Park City will conduct by-mail elections for the Municipal General Election in November. South Summit Fire District and Service Area #3 also have board seats to elect. A Bond Election will be on the ballot for all voters in the South Summit School District. All registered voters of these municipalities, service districts, and South Summit School District will receive a mail-in ballot at their registered mailing address, or a requested absentee address. Ballots will be mailed on October 17, 2017.

All ballots will include a return envelope to be sent to the Summit County Clerk and **must be post marked on or before November 6, 2017** or dropped off at a **drop box on or before Election Day** at their city recorder's office, designated drop box locations, or at the Summit County Clerk's office during business hours. Anyone who does not receive a mail in ballot should contact the Summit County Clerk at 435-336-3204.

BOND PROPOSAL

Shall the Board of Education of South Summit School District, Utah, be authorized to issue General Obligation Bonds in a principal amount not to exceed Fifty-eight Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$58,650,000) for the purpose of paying all or a portion of the costs to acquire land; acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping new school facilities; improving or rebuilding existing facilities; and the authorization and issuance of the Bonds due and payable with a term not to exceed twenty-one (21) years from the date or dates of issuance of the Bonds?

PROPERTY TAX COST OF THE BONDS

If the Bonds are issued as planned, an annual property tax to pay debt service on the Bonds will be required over a period of twenty (20) years in the estimated amount of \$297.02 on a \$310,000 residence and in the estimated amount of \$540.04 on a business property having the same value.

The foregoing information is only an estimate and is not a limit on the amount of taxes that the District may be required to levy to pay debt service on the Bonds. The District is obligated to levy taxes to the extent provided by law in order to pay the Bonds.
